





Learning Plan: Ambulance Virtual Tour

Key learning objectives:

- Learn about emergency ambulances, ambulance crews and how they can help us
- Explore inside/outside of an ambulance
- Understand what equipment is on board an emergency ambulance and how and why it is used.

Activity	Timings	Resources
1. Ask students to discuss what they know about ambulances <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why might you need an ambulance? • How can an ambulance crew help you? • When and how can you contact 999? • What kinds of equipment might you find on an ambulance? • What sound does an ambulance make and what should you do if you hear one? 	5 mins	
2. Visit the Ambulance 360 virtual tour:	15 mins	Screen / projector /

Behind the icons are a mixture of short films presented by a paramedic and photographs and text explaining what the equipment is and what it's used for.</p>		tablets / laptop
3.	Ask students to discuss anything new they've learnt from exploring the ambulance tour	5 mins	
4.	<p>Recap and discuss learning points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Call 999 in an emergency, when someone is seriously ill or injured or their life is at risk • 999 is available all day every day and is free to call • An ambulance crew can help you using the medication and equipment carried on the ambulance to treat you or take you to hospital • If you hear an emergency siren from an ambulance, police car or fire engine make sure you stay safe on the pavement 	5 mins
